Reopening of the Church for Private Prayer

The government has now reopened for private prayer and we are happy that St Marie's has opened. There are still some restrictions which we need to follow.

- 1) The church is open from 11am to 1pm and from 4pm to 6pm on Mondays and Thursdays.
- 2) The reopening is for private prayer only. Come in and pray quietly. There is no permission for attendance at Mass or for group prayer such as the Rosary.
- 3) Social distancing will be necessary. Places in church will be marked for visitors.
- 4) Stewards will be present to explain the restrictions and to guide you. As in previous weeks, Mass will still be live streamed at 10am each day. This is a very important step forward, and we look forward to seeing you in church again.

Sundays 10.00 AM and 06.00 PM

Please remember, at present the **Sunday Obligation has been lifted** and any mass will fulfil your obligation. With this in mind we need your support on any of the above days. In order to function most effectively and maintain people's health and safety, **we need 3 stewards to support each mass** and to help clean the church after the mass. The stewards should be below 70 years old. If you would like to be a steward please let Fr Jose or myself know by Thursday 9th July 2020 by emailing the parish email or calling the Parish Office. The church has a reduced capacity due to social distancing regulation (this is applicable mainly on Saturdays and Sundays). We recommend that you **arrive from 15 minutes before mass** to enable stewards sufficient time to implement health and safety measures. **Guidelines about the mass will be available at the entrance of the church.** If you are feeling unwell or have any other symptoms please stay at home and rest following government guidelines. Next Week's Gospel Reading Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time Matthew 13:1-23

That same day Jesus went out of the house and sat by the lake. Such large crowds gathered around him that he got into a boat and sat in it, while all the people stood on the shore. Then he told them many things in parables, saying: "A farmer went out to sow his seed. As he was scattering the seed, some fell along the path, and the birds came and ate it up. Some fell on rocky places, where it did not have much soil. It sprang up quickly, because the soil was shallow. But when the sun came up, the plants were scorched, and they withered because they had no root. Other seed fell among thorns, which grew up and choked the plants. Still other seed fell on good soil, where it produced a crop—a hundred, sixty or thirty times what was sown. Whoever has ears, let them hear." The disciples came to him and asked, "Why do you speak to the people in parables?" He replied, "Because the knowledge of the secrets of the kingdom of heaven has been given to you, but not to them. Whoever has will be given more, and they will have an abundance. Whoever does not have, even what they have will be taken from them. [...]"
