Next Week's Gospel Reading Fourth Sunday of Easter (22nd April 2018)

Gospel – John 10:11-18

“I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep. The hired hand, who is not the shepherd and does not own the sheep, sees the wolf coming and leaves the sheep and runs away—and the wolf snatches them and scatters them. The hired hand runs away because a hired hand does not care for the sheep. I am the good shepherd. I know my own and my own know me, just as the Father knows me and I know the Father. And I lay down my life for the sheep. I have other sheep that do not belong to this fold. I must bring them also, and they will listen to my voice. So there will be one flock, one shepherd. For this reason the Father loves me, because I lay down my life in order to take it up again. No one takes it from me, but I lay it down of my own accord. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it up again. I have received this command from my Father.”

Restoration Funds - total raised to date

Information - There are plans to change the Church lighting to **LED** as the present lights do not last very long and is quite expensive to keep bringing the electrician in to keep changing them. I am working with Tom Hargadon and Mike Borg to get three quotes and present them to the Finance Committee for approval.

Sound System - There have been a lot of suggestions regarding our sound system in the church, since it is not audible a lot of the time. The Sound Engineer has always been very responsive to the many call outs. I have now asked him to look at updating the system in making it more audible. At the moment I am not sure of any costs involved. I will update you after his visit.

Stations of the Cross by the North Porch - cost of repair £1390+ VAT, Travel £180+VAT, two nights accommodation.

Hibbert's Chapel Ceiling Repair: £2800 + VAT, Travel cost £180+VAT, accommodation for two people over three nights, plus scaffolding hire costs. I look forward to hear your suggestions and plans. Fr. Tom

Repairs are needed on our South Wall, Stations of the Cross, Chapel Ceiling, Lighting inside the Church, Boiler, Organ, and also Hibbert's.
