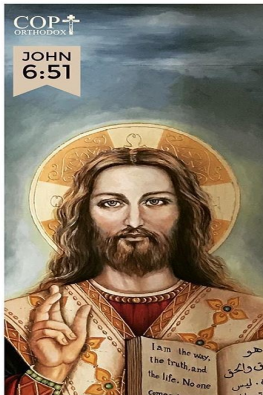
'No one can come to me unless he is drawn by the Father who sent me, and I will raise him up at the last day. It is written in the prophets:
