They carried the highest burden which included prolonged isolation, the distress for families being unable to visit, delayed medical interventions and tragic, isolated, deaths followed by shortened, minimal, funeral rites. Many family members and friends continue to bear the wound of deep grief which hurts and is still in need of healing. We reflect on this on The Day for Life, Sunday 19th June, and ask our parishioners to pray for those still facing hardships caused by the pandemic. 

This week's Gospel – Luke 9:11-17
The feeding of the five thousand.

Jesus made the crowds welcome and talked to them about the kingdom of God; and he cured those who were in need of healing. It was late afternoon when the Twelve came to him and said, 'Send the people away, and they can go to the villages and farms round about to find lodging and food; for we are in a lonely place here.' He replied, 'Give them something to eat yourselves.' But they said, 'We have no more than five loaves and two fish, unless we are to go ourselves and buy food for all these people.' For there were about five thousand men. But he said to his disciples, 'Get them to sit down in parties of about fifty.' They did so and made them all sit down. Then he took the five loaves and the two fish, raised his eyes to heaven, and said the blessing over them; then he broke them and handed them to his disciples to distribute among the crowd. They all ate as much as they wanted, and when the scraps remaining were collected they filled twelve baskets.



First Holy Communion Certificates

The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ is celebrated on Sunday 19th June, and on this day our first Holy Communion children will receive their certificates at the 10am mass. All our candidates are invited to attend, and to wear their dresses/suits for the occasion if they wish. There will be a procession of the blessed sacrament after the mass (weather permitting).

LIDL Food Collection and Delivery Service

We are in need of new volunteers to help with the collection and distribution of donated food from Lidl. This would require some hours on one day every 4-5 weeks, depending on the number of volunteers, to collect donations from Lidl, to sort it out in parcels and distribute them to the recipient families across the Rugby area.

At the moment, the donations are reaching 10 households who are really thankful for this help. However, at this moment of increasing inflation it is likely that more people may need help and we need additional volunteers to allow the donated food to reach these members of our community.
