UKRAINE The Archdiocese are pleased to say that since we sent out our last update, Fr Hudson's Care has received numerous offers of sponsorship & accommodation and of translation skills in Russian and Ukrainian. The evident enthusiasm for support from our parishes and parishioners is a great testament to our faith. As we understand it only a few refugees have arrived from Ukraine so far under the families' scheme, and they have been accommodated with family members. We are not aware of anyone yet arriving under the Homes for Ukraine scheme, needing housing or schooling. We are expecting some more guidance from the government on the matching process over the coming days. Father Hudson's is happy to continue to receive offers of accommodation and language services and to support and remain in touch with those who offer their help please contact Father Hudson's on (01675) 434000 between the hours of 8.30 – 5.00pm Monday to Thursday, and 8.30 – 4.30pm on Friday.
