
Ss Peter and Paul Sunday


St Marie's Winter Shelter We are the delighted recipients of £10,000 from the National Lottery Fund which will enable us to make Hibbert's a safer and warmer place for the Night Shelter.

- We have almost completed the installation of the fire alarm system which will make us compliant.
- We are replacing the front doors which will reduce the heat loss and improve security.
- We are having the flat roof re-done above the ladies loos which will reduce heat loss.
- The broken glass and putty will be replaced on the windows around the hall.

As you will imagine, all of this work is very expensive and would not have been covered by the Lottery fund alone, so we are very grateful for the private donations, the money raised through the Quiz and also the donation from the Heart of England.

Our thanks also go to Kieran Murray for the considerable amount of time and skill he has put into making sure that we got the correct fire system in place. Additionally, Kevin Baugh, Diocesan Fund Raiser for his expertise and advice on how to apply to the National Lottery. Thank you to Kathy for taking this initiative forward.
