Jesus began to speak in the synagogue: 'This text is being fulfilled today even as you listen.' And he won the approval of all, and they were astonished by the gracious words that came from his lips. They said, 'This is Joseph's son, surely?' But he replied, 'No doubt you will quote me the saying, "Physician, heal yourself" and tell me, "We have heard all that happened in Capernaum, do the same here in your own countryside."' And he went on, 'I tell you solemnly, no prophet is ever accepted in his own country. 'There were many widows in Israel, I can assure you, in Elijah's day, when heaven remained shut for three years and six months and a great famine raged throughout the land, but Elijah was not sent to any ..... a Sidonian town.' 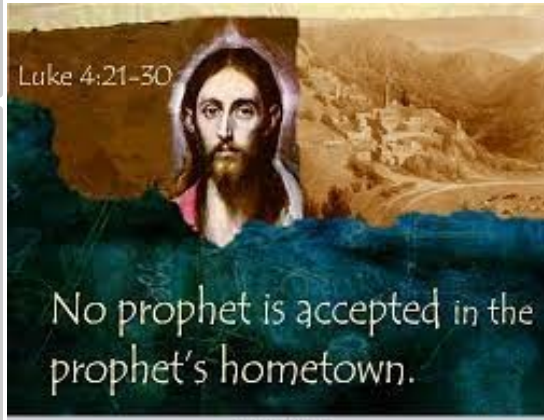

**Feast Word On The Street** You may be familiar with *Migrateful*, a charity that facilitates cookery classes with chefs from all corners of the globe. It provides a solution for the isolation refugees can often face upon arriving in the UK. A restaurant called *Feast*, a World Kitchen, has been set up which allows refugee chefs to have a pop-up kitchen for a day a week and cook the food from their country. They publish their menus for the 4 days of the week and customers order for take-away at the time they want. It helps them develop their cooking skills, prove the commercial success of their menus, create income and build confidence to open their own restaurant.
