We are please to announce that St Marie's has reopened its doors for holy mass from Monday 13th July 2020. I thank you for your support during these difficult and uncertain times.

Masses will take place at following times:

Monday to Friday: 10.00 AM

Saturday 09.30 AM and 06.00 PM

Sundays 10.00 AM and 06.00 PM

Guidelines for Mass:

- Please remember, at present **the Sunday Obligation has been lifted** and any mass will fulfil your obligation.
- **If you are not working, please come to a weekday mass** to leave space for those who are working to attend mass at the weekend.
- The **church has a reduced capacity (55 places)** due to social distancing regulations. We recommend that you **arrive from 15 minutes before mass** to enable the stewards sufficient time to implement health and safety measures. **Places in church will be allocated on a first-come-first-served-basis.**
- Household groups will be permitted to share a pew. Where possible we ask that members of the same household attend the same mass in order to maximise the number of people in church.
- When mass begins, singing is not permitted.
- **Hand-shaking is also not permitted during the sign of peace.**
- **Please receive the Holy Communion with outstretched arm and on your hand only.**
- **Exit through the side door or main door starting from the back pews.**
- There will be no lighting of candles permitted.
- **Wearing mask/face covering** is necessary at distances of less than 2 metres and **is always preferable** in a populated place.

Next Week's Gospel Reading Eighteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time Matthew 14:13-21

When Jesus heard what had happened, he withdrew by boat privately to a solitary place. Hearing of this, the crowds followed him on foot from the towns. When Jesus landed and saw a large crowd, he had compassion on them and healed their sick. As evening approached, the disciples came to him and said, "This is a remote place, and it's already getting late. Send the crowds away, so they can go to the villages and buy themselves some food." Jesus replied, "They do not need to go away. You give them something to eat." "We have here only five loaves of bread and two fish," they answered. "Bring them here to me," he said. And he directed the people to sit down on the grass. Taking the five loaves and the two fish and looking up to heaven, he gave thanks and broke the loaves. Then he gave them to the disciples, and the disciples gave them to the people. They all ate and were satisfied, and the disciples picked up twelve basketfuls of broken pieces that were left over. The number of those who ate was about five thousand men, besides women and children.
